NAPLES WALKING TOUR

Starting at Piazza San Domenico Maggiore (stop there at Pasticceria Scaturchio to try “Neapolitan Pastiera”... it’s sweet). Continuing in via Benedetto Croce till Piazza del Gesù (visit the Monastero of Santa Chiara on your left and the Church of Gesù Nuovo on your right). Then take via Domenico Capitegli and stop at “Pescheria Acqua Pazza” and try some “octopus street food” or have a wine tasting at “Enoteca Red Wine” in Calata Trinità Maggiore, 19, 80134 Napoli NA, then continue through Via Domenico Capitegli and after 300 mt turn left in “Via Toledo”. Walk for about 300 mt and turn right in “Via Piagnasecca”. The “Pignasecca market” is a very authentic Neapolitan open market (also famous for “trippa shops” ...you can try some Trippa if you want) Walk for 400 mt and take the cable car “Funicolare of Montesanto” till Vomero (last stop. Just 6 minutes). Try some street food at “Friggitoria Vomero” in Via Cimarosa or have a sit for lunch or dinner at Trattoria “Donna Teresa” in Via Kerbaker 58, then visit the “Sant’Elmo castle” and the Certosa of San Martino (take pictures of the gulf of Naples by the terrace). Then walk down through via Morghen and Via Scarlatti and take the other cable car “Funicolare of Chiaia” in Via Cimarosa and stop at “Parco Margherita”. Exit the Funicolare turn right and reach Piazza Amedeo. Then walk through “Via Vittorio Colonna” and “Via dei Mille” till “Piazza dei Martiri” and then go to “Piazza Vittoria” just in front of the sea (if you’re hungry try the best fried pizza at “La Masardona”). Then follow the promenade on the left till Castel Dell’ovo (the castle on the sea). You can visit the castel or walk through “Borgo dei Marinari”. Then take Via Santa Lucia till Piazza del Plebiscito. Visit the Royal Palace of Naples and have a look at the “San Carlo theater” (the oldest opera theater in Europe). Continuing through Via Toledo stop at “Pasticceria Pintauro” where “sfogliatella” was created and try it for a sweet moment... have a walk in Quartieri Spagnoli till “Maradona Murales” in via Emanuele De Deo. Then go back to Via Toledo and visit the new and wonderful “Gallerie d’Italia” Then take Via Santa Brigida just in front of “Pasticceria Pintauro”. Visit the “Umberto Gallery” on your right. Then Come back in via Santa Brigida and reach the “Maschio Angioino” Castle. Turn left, pass through Piazza Municipio and have a drink at “Barrio Botanico bar” in Via Medina 24.
